

### Sociology Expectations

Expectations	This course is designed to acquaint the student with the study of human relationships and human behavior in groups. Focus is placed on social groups, social institutions, and the interaction of individuals within the larger society.
Reading Homework:	1-2 pages per night
Writing Homework:	Chapter vocabulary, Current events, and short answer response
In class Note-Taking:	Daily journal entries and note-taking on lectures and discussions
Essay Assignments:	1-2 timed essays a quarter
Critical Thinking:	Analysis of 1-2 primary sources a week Analysis of current issues and how they relate to sociology.
Participation:	Active daily participation through discussions and journal entries
Assessment:	Daily discussions, chapter vocabulary quizzes, and unit tests (multiple choice and essay)
Attendance:	Attendance is critical to be successful in this class. There is no substitute for daily lectures, teacher led discussions and consistent participation.
Maturity/Responsibility:	Responsible young adult with a good work ethic and a positive attitude. Open minded and respectful of others' opinions. We will cover a number of sensitive matters that a high level maturity will be expected.
