- -Teachers have been hired for the following vacancies-
- 2 Math, 1 English, 1 Band, 1 Theater Arts, 1 History, 1 Autism
- -Currently 4 vacancies-
- 1 Social Studies, 1 PE, 1 Biology/Chemistry
- -There are 3 weeks left for internal transfer, followed by surplus and then positions are available to new hires (out of district; newly graduated)

2.2 Financial update

- -Teachers currently developing supply wish lists for 2018-2019. These supplies are purchased under 2017-2018 budget.
- -Mr. Piccininni getting bids to resurface basketball courts outside near tennis courts.

 Roughly \$10,000 to complete. Football and soccer fields currently in good shape.
- -May need to replace at least one copy machine (\$13,000 each). Coronado makes 25-30 million copies each year.

2.3 School Improvement Plan update

-Coronado faculty looking to devise a plan to address the extremely competitive nature of today's students and focusing on student mental health/well being. Priority is to reevaluate how Coronado is achieving and to help students find a better balance.
