- \Rightarrow Grade of an A /B in Algebra/Geometry; recommendation to Honors at the next level (if available)
- \Rightarrow Grade of an A in Pre-Algebra
- \Rightarrow You must have an A in either English or Math
- \Rightarrow Two teacher recommendations (English and Math teachers)
- \Rightarrow Zoned for Coronado High School

- * Get an overview of the AP program from administrators, teachers, and students.

- * Be informed about the academic entrance requirements for the AP Academy, including the suggested course sequence for high school.
