The Coronado High School Organizational Team meeting was called to order at 3:30 p.m. The meeting was held in the Coronado High School library, 1001 Coronado Center Drive, Henderson NV 89052.

1.0 Basic Matters of Business:

1.1 **Approval of Minutes:** Ellen Noto made motion to approve the September 12th meeting minutes. Stacey Shaffer seconded motion. Motion passed with 8-0 vote.

2.0 New Items to Address:

2.1 **SOT Elections:**

- Stacey Allen nominated Michelle Tidball for Chair. Team voted 8-0 for Michelle to serve as Chair for 2019-2020.
- Michelle Tidball nominated Stacey Shaffer for Vice-Chair. Team voted 8-0 for Stacey Shaffer to serve as Vice-Chair for 2019-2020.
- Eric Marshall nominated Stacey Allen for Secretary. Team voted 8-0 for Stacey Allen to serve as Secretary for 2019-2020.
- Jenn Blackhurst will continue to serve as Team's Community Member.

- 2.2 Budget Update:** 2019-2020 budget has been submitted and approved
- 15 prep-buyouts = \$71,980; all strategic placements for credit retrieval and social/emotional health
 - moved the remainder to instructional supplies
 - \$528,000-to be put towards library improvements
 - \$200,000-for carryover
 - may be some repair expenses (umbrellas, desks, etc.)

2.3 School Improvement Plan: Ms. Delgado gave overview of Coronado's 2019-2020 School Improvement Plan. Goals/Priorities include:

1. Increase the College and Career Readiness of all students as measured by their performance on the ACT and decrease student proficiency gaps in ELA, math and science in alignment with Focus 2024 plan.
2. Increase the percentage of 9th grade students who are credit sufficient from 91.2% to 95% by the end of SY 19-20 as measured by Infinite Campus and reported on the Nevada Performance Framework and in alignment with Focus 2024 plan.
3. Reduce the percent of chronically absent students from 14.4% to 10% by the end of SY 19-20 as measured by Infinite Campus and reported on the Nevada School Performance Framework and in alignment with Focus 2024 plan.
4. Increase percentage of school-based personnel trained in cultural effectiveness strategies in alignment with Focus 2024 plan.
5. Increase the number of students completing Advanced Placement, Dual-Credit, and Career and Technical Education courses each year in alignment with Focus 2024 plan.
6. We will improve access and availability to technology for students, faculty and staff.
7. Increase parent/student participation at school events through improved engagement on all social media platforms.
