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Opening Day of School Procedures Welcome Cougars!

The first day of school for all students is **Monday**, **August 24**, **2020**, **@ 8:00 a.m**.

At 7:55 a.m., students should be navigating to their teachers' websites found at <u>www.coronadocougars.net</u> and click the link to <u>Clever</u>, sign in using their CCSD Google credentials and passwords, and click the Canvas icon to access their courses. In Canvas, students will see all courses on their schedules and should attend each course according to their unique period schedules and teachers. Teachers will have links within their Canvas courses to student Google Meets to conduct live sessions at the times listed below.

Students are to login to live sessions with cameras off and microphones on MUTE until directed they are allowed to do otherwise by the instructor. Prior to the first day, students should have located their teachers' websites or bookmarked them for easy access.

*If a student cannot log into Clever/Canvas due to system error, teachers will post Google Meet links to their Google Classrooms OR to their Remind101 accounts for students only. Teachers will be emailing the join codes/links to students <u>PRIOR</u> to Monday, August 24, 2020 and students should make it priority to join upon receipt.

Below are step-by-step directions to get you started on the first day of school. After each step is a picture illustrating each step. Please make sure you access this page on **Monday**, **August 24**, by 7:10 a.m. for updates.

1. On Monday, **August 24, 2020**, no later than 8:10 a.m., open a web browser on your computer and go to Google.com. It is highly recommended that you use Google Chrome. If you do not have Google Chrome you can download it here <u>https://www.google.com/chrome/</u>.



2. Go to Google.com and click on *Sign In* at the top, right of your screen.



3. If you see your student CCSD Gmail address, click on it. If you do not see your student CCSD Gmail address, click on *Use another account*.

- 5. If you do not know your CCSD Student Gmail address it is your FIRST name and personal identification number with @nv.ccsd.net (ex: <u>Michael1234567@nv.ccsd.net</u>).
- 6. Type in your password, then click Next.



- 7. If you need to reset your password go to <u>myaccount.ccsd.net</u> and click on Reset Your Password or Retrieve Your Current CCSD Standard ID (Active Directory). Follow the steps to reset your password and/or get your username. If this STILL doesn't work (it should) please email <u>arnolp@nv.ccsd.net</u> OR <u>pollaad@nv.ccsd.net</u>
- 8. At the top of your screen in the gray box type clever.ccsd.net or follow this link. <u>Clever.CCSD.net</u>

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9. Go to <u>Clever.CCSD.net</u>.

10. There are two options after you go to <u>Clever.CCSD.net</u>. If Option 1 does not work, try Option 2.



11. If you do not remember your username or password or need to reset your password go to <u>myaccount.ccsd.net</u> and click on Reset Your Password or Retrieve Your Current CCSD Standard ID (Active Directory). Follow the steps to reset your password and/or get your username.



12. After you log into Clever, click on the red, Canvas icon at the top of the screen.

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- 13. If this is your first time logging in to Canvas, you will read and accept the Acceptable Use Policy.
- 14. After you accept the Acceptable Use Policy you will automatically be on your "Dashboard".
- 15. Click on "Courses" on the left hand side of the screen.
- 16. Click on your first period course. It will have Po1 in the name of the course.
- 17. You will see a white box pop up, and all of your courses will be listed.
- 18. Click on your first period class (and subsequent classes for the day)
- 19. Click on *Join Now* to enter the Google Meet session.
